INTRODUCTION

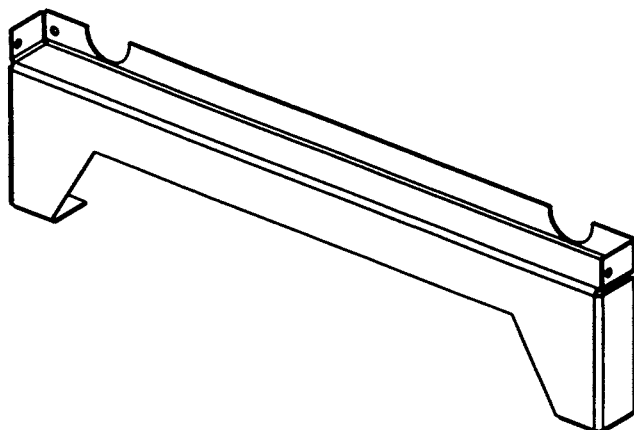


Fig. 1 – Subbase (2 Supplied per Accessory Kit)

The subbase accessory (Fig. 1) provides a stable, raised platform for 6 to 30 ton packaged air-handling units. The accessory is recommended for all vertical installations to enable condensate trap construction. See Table 1 for usage by unit size.

INSTALLATION

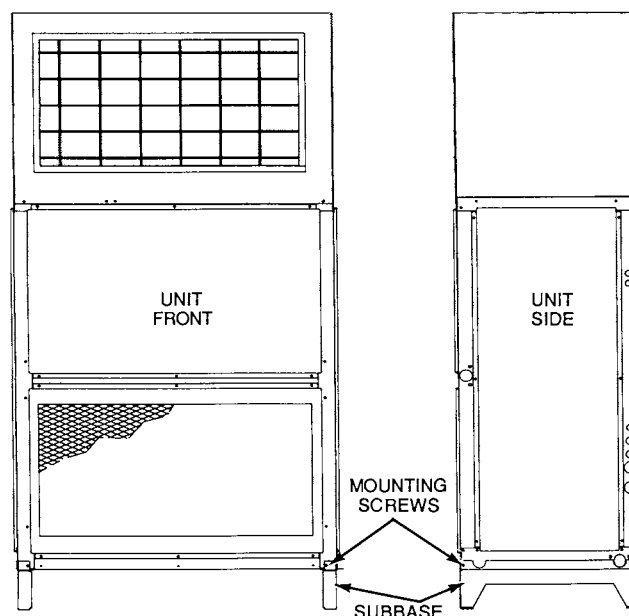


Fig. 2 – Subbase Installation

Refer to Fig. 2 while performing the following steps:

1. Raise and support one end of the unit higher than the subbase leg height of 6 in. (152 mm).
2. Remove the 2 screws from each of the 2 raised bottom corners of the unit.
3. Place a subbase leg in position on the raised end of the unit. Align the leg mounting holes with the holes in the unit base.
4. Using the screws removed in Step 1, fasten the leg to the bottom of the unit. Tighten all screws and lower the unit onto the subbase leg.
5. Repeat Steps 1-4 for the second leg on the opposite side of the unit.
6. Install the unit according to the base unit Installation, Start-Up and Service instructions.
